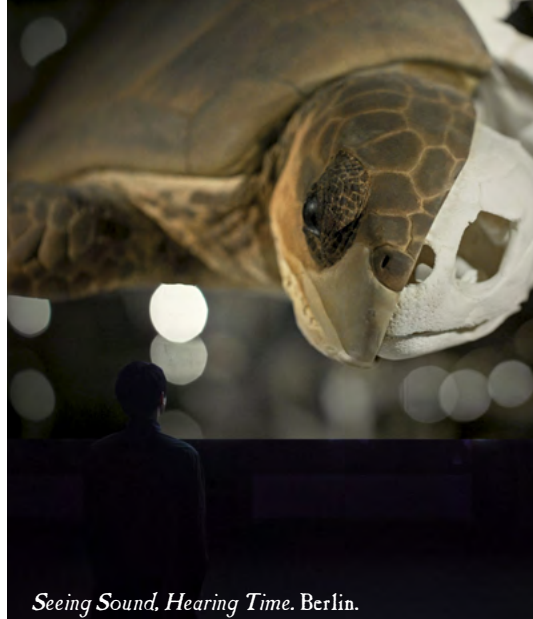

Hamburg. 3 Days.

Then, privately explore the venerable workshops of Steinway and Montblanc and visit Bunker St. Pauli, a colossal WWII concrete fortress reborn as a breathtaking vertical park. Conclude with a post-concert reception alongside members of the CSO.

Berlin. 2 days.

Stay at The Ritz-Carlton, Berlin, an Art Deco-inspired retreat in Potsdamer Platz. Experience Ryuichi Sakamoto's *Seeing Sound, Hearing Time* at Hamburger Bahnhof, followed by *Salome* or *The Nutcracker*. Enjoy private access to the Neue Nationalgalerie and Maurizio Cattelan's provocative exhibition, then admire the Pierre Boulez Hall's architecture. Conclude with a distinctly German dinner.

Paris. 3 Days.

The Mandarin Oriental Lutetia Paris is our Left Bank address, with the charm, cafés, and shopping of Saint-Germain-des-Près at your doorstep. Discover Paris through privileged access to its art institutions and the world of French high jewelry, from contemporary architecture and Impressionist masterpieces to extraordinary craftsmanship and storied treasures. Conclude with dining and opportunities to connect with CSO musicians.

Wednesday, 13 January 2027

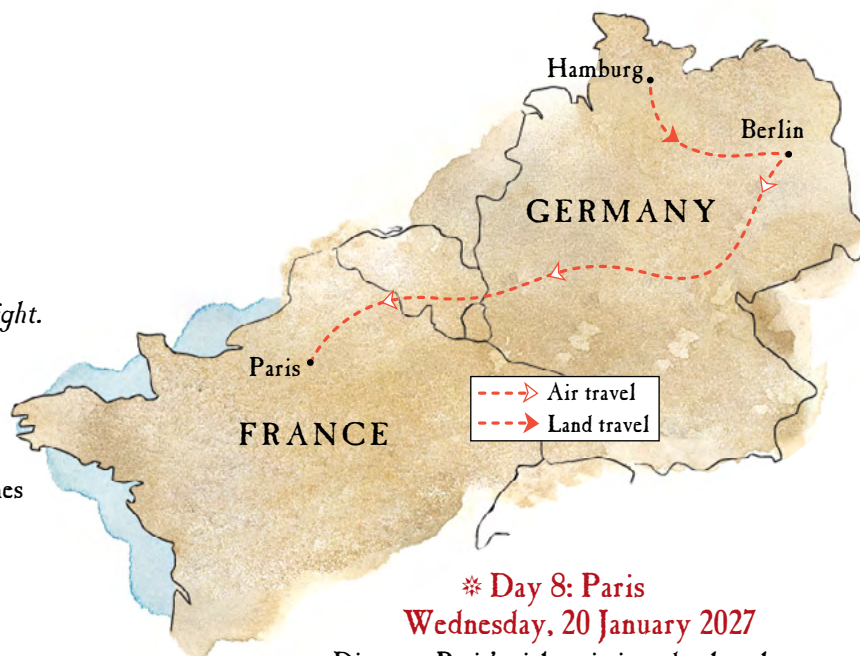
Monday, 18 January 2027

The tour is sold as described. Space on this tour is limited. Bookings are taken on a first come, first served basis. There are no refunds for unused portions of this journey. The tour price is based on a minimum of 24 travelers at present fuel and currency exchange rates. If fewer than the minimum number of travelers participates, or if there is a major change fuel or currency exchange rates, a price supplement may apply and/or the itinerary may be adjusted. All breakfasts are included in the tour price, plus at least one lunch or dinner each day. Full terms and conditions will be provided separately. Expect a detailed itinerary a few weeks before departure.

Concert tickets are limited and available only to CSO patrons participating in the tour. Patrons receive a separate invoice from the CSO for the performance tickets and donation.

*** Inclusions.** Accommodations (based on double occupancy); arrival airport transfer; ground transportation; sightseeing as indicated; meal as indicated with local wine and beer with included meals; hotel taxes; entrance fees; Berlin concert ticket to *Salome* or *The Nutcracker* with best available seats; first-class train ticket (Hamburg-Berlin); gratuity for drivers, guides, hotel porters, and included meals; baggage handling; tour development and planning; reservation management by R. Crusoe travel advisor; and preparation and delivery of preliminary and final documents.
